

International Projects

Rotary assists with large and small international projects, including emergency disaster relief, water and sanitation projects in third world projects and disease elimination projects. One example of this is the eradication of polio.

Our Rotary Club through its fund-raising efforts contributes, along with other Rotary Clubs in our District to this effort.

Since 1988, we've seen a worldwide reduction in polio cases of 99.9%. It should be noted that since 2013, the Gates Foundation has matched every \$1 Rotary commits to polio eradication.

Our Rotary Club is also assisting an orphanage and school library in Cambodia, and is funding underprivileged students in Mongolia. We also played a role in setting up a new Rotary Club in East Timor in 2016.
