Presidents Report for 1 August 2018

On Wednesday the members and guests present were the recipients of a presentation by an incredible young lady from Monash Rotaract. Netania is the Immediate past President of Monash Rotaract and the current National Communications Director for Rotaract Australia.

Netania was sponsored by our club a couple of years ago and this helped her along her Rotary path. She spoke about how the branding of our image matters and the importance of storytelling the Rotary story, not just talking about numbers and money. It is important to talk about why we are Rotarian not just what it is. The first impression we make is so important and consistency is the key. Netania also spoke about relevance and maintaining the Rotary theme of Service Above Self and being consistent with the message we give, putting the emphasis on volunteering. What we stand for should be at the forefront of everything.

Also Rotaractors are not just Rotaractors but actually young Rotarians now and they need people who are willing to invest in them, not just support by coming to meetings etc..

Marketing and strategy are critical and the goals for the coming year need to be set. Then determine what needs to be done to achieve them in the coming year. Netania spoke about social media and how it is here to stay and that we need to be fully on board.

Overall an excellent presentation and certainly good food for thought about our direction.

The talk was very relevant as we have as a board action item how to engage with Rotaract. This will be discussed at the next board meeting.

The planned member behind the badge presentation has been put off to a future date due to Nicholas having come down with the bug!

At the meeting I spoke about the Four Way Test and it was interesting that Netania also mentioned in her presentation. It is very timely to review this as we have quite a few new members amongst us and as stated before it is our guiding principle.

As I mentioned at the meeting another area I feel we need to refocus on is family violence. It is easy for this to get overlooked when the media coverage is on other forms of violence. I was reminded of this due to an incident not far from home. Any thoughts on how to proceed in this area would be appreciated.
