We have been catching up with quite a few of the young people we have been working with over the years and also Vantha who is the person we are sponsoring in a leadership program in Australia in October/November. He will be speaking at our club meeting on the 7th November. We have also made contact with another Australian charity that is working on a program called one family at a time. We are exploring possible future activities with them. The founder of this charity lives in Ringwood so we can easily maintain personal contact. The next part of the report has been put together by a few people in the club who provided information on last weeks meeting. My thanks to them for their support.

A small enthusiastic group attended last weeks meeting to hear our guest speaker Steve Marantelli. Miranda did a great job as chairman and was fined by Terry for doing such a great job: Miranda will make a great President when her time comes. Lou was his normal witty self and handled the filling in as President admirably. Many members are still away on holidays, but the evening seemed to be enjoyed by all.

Our guest speaker was a history buff and presented a wealth of fascinating facts on the legislative assembly in the USA, focussing in particular on how the development of the formulae for assessing how African American slaves gradually gained representation in USA politics. This involved reaching a compromise between the north and south by way of a "Federal Ratio" to count every five slaves as three citizens on the census. Steve compared and contrasted the developments in the USA with the aboriginal franchise and representation in Australia. Steve Marantelli is the author of the book "The Three Brothers – When George Washington and Edmund Barton sat down to Dinner" and he kindly donated a percentage of his book sales on the night to MWCIS.

FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITY

Thanks to Roger Mould, we have been able to obtain a number of insulated food carry boxes. The boxes are brand new and sealed, made with tough vinyl, with silver lining and quality insulation panels. These came from the Food Service industry and are surplus to requirements.

Dimensions are 50 cm wide, 50 cm deep and 40 cm high. The lid and insulation panels are secured by top quality Velcro. There is a removal internal shelf and some dividing panels. A very innovative design that can be used for temporary car boot storage in lieu of phased out plastic bags, or as a high quality storage unit for camping or day trips.

Photos appear below. I showed one to members at our last meeting, and the reaction was very positive. I suggest that we can give these away to any interested parties, in return for a donation to our Community Account funds. I propose that a fair reserve donation is no less than \$10. Members can also avail themselves of this opportunity for a donation.

We have a limited number in storage at Notting Hill. If you know of anybody that might be interested, please contact me ASAP. I will be meeting with MWCIS later this week with a view to placing some with them, so be quick.
