### President's Report for week to 13<sup>th</sup> May 2018.

At this week's Wednesday night meeting last week we had as our guest speaker Terry Nunn. Terry, a retired ambulance driver/paramedic spent 35 wonderful years in the ambulance service finally joining the retired ranks in 2012. He shared with us many of his life's experiences while in the service and his passion and dedication to his job in such an intense environment where still very much evident despite being retired. We thank Terry and his wife Rose for making the time to come visit with us.

At our weekly meeting we also considered and voted for the two resolutions as nominated by PDG David Alexander, the District delegate to the 2018 Council on Resolutions. The resolutions passed were:-

1. To request the Trustees to consider Environment as a key element for health protection and to include Environmental Risk Reduction as standard measure for the Disease Prevention and Treatment (DP7T) Focus Area. Proposed by RC Manningham.
2. To request the RI Board to consider officially recognising Early Act as a Rotary program. Proposed by the RC of Rowville-Lysterfield.

We also held our monthly Board meeting last Wednesday night, being the second last for this financial year. A range of matters were discussed including market rosters, the Club changeover night and various committee reports. Payments were approved for Rotary Foundation and Rotary Health, The Tennant Creek primary school, and our Cambodian project.
