Presidents Report for 15 August 2018



We had a good turn out for the last weeks meeting and those attending heard an interesting talk from our DG Russell Gurney. Russell spoke about the Rotary International presidents message about being The Inspiration to build for the future, have the best experience for members and to continue to grow the number of members throughout the world. India is rapidly growing and will become the centre of Rotary sometime in the future. While numbers are growing through the world to 1.2m, District 9810 has dropped from around 2000 to 1120, nearly half. Our clubs target is to recruit at least 3 new members this year whilst maintaining the current members.

The RI board has now included environmental issues in the overall plan. This was deemed an important issue as some Pacific islands are facing extinction due to rising water and the Bahamas will be under water within 50 years. Russell also spoke about the importance of building Rotoract and help it become a real focus in the Rotary world. At the board meeting it was decided that we will roster two of our members to attend their fortnightly meeting to understand how we can become effectively involved.

Russell commented on how Rotary needs to become streamlined, modernised, diversify and remain relevant. His suggestion is that current members and new members be treated as customers and ensure new members are actively engaged. We must increase our ability to adapt and be willing to take risks. Also mentioned was the partnership between Rotary, Channel 9 and the National Farmers Federation to support farmers suffering from the severe drought conditions being experienced in some parts of Australia. At the board meeting it was decided that our club would donate \$1000 to this cause.

Russell had a number of positive things to say about our club and encouraged us to grow membership and continue to diversify in our member recruitment. Overall a very positive report back from DG Russell.

Russells wife and fellow Rotarian Shelley, spoke about her passion for the Rotary Against Malaria project and her personal experience of their young son and herself contracting malaria whilst living in PNG. Shelley spoke about the Mosquito net program and its effectiveness. The importance of the malaria project was emphasised by the fact that 1000 people each day are dying from malaria.

At the board meeting held after the general meeting a number of issues were discussed and will be in the minutes to be posted on the webpage. Amendments to the bylaw were discussed and will be circulated before being voted on at the AGM on the 29th August.

Beth has also let me know that the market this Sunday took in close to \$1,100. A good result! Thank you to all involved. We have a number of events coming up including the trivia night on 6th October and all member and partners are invited to our place for a social fun evening on the 31st August.

Peter Rees has recently had major surgery and we wish him a speedy and full recovery.
