Presidents Report for 17 October 2018

We had a very interesting insight into the Rotary International Conference held in Toronto in June this year. Beth, Ros and Loretta were very entertaining while they described some of the events of the conference, social activities and places visited.

The conference had an interesting mix of very high profile speakers including the Prime Minister of Canada and Princess Anne along with the Past President Ian Riseley and the incoming president Barry Rassin. The atmosphere in the conference centre must have been amazing with 25,000 attendees. Ros Beth and Loretta commented on how the conference opens your eyes to the wide spread of activities that Rotary International is involved in and the good works being done in most parts of the world. Next years international conference will held in Hamburg Germany with Melbourne being a possibility in 2023.

We held a board meeting after last weeks meeting and it was decided that as a club we would donate to shelter box and support the MWSC interact group shelter box which will provide disaster relief to the tsunami and earthquake in Indonesia.

I have spoken briefly to Chris Bassington from MWCIS about a new project we are getting underway. Similar to a project Ivona was involved in earlier this year the plan is to make up small packs of essentials for emergency support for families seeking refuge. So if you have any items like shampoos, soaps, toothbrushes etc. that you have picked up from hotels, airlines or the like, including the small carry bags could you please bring them along to the meetings or drop them off at our place. Ivona and Rhonda will then make up the packs and drop them off to MWCIS.

The market was on again this weekend in hot conditions but it seemed to bring people out resulting in takings of approx. \$1300, a great result. A big thank you to all involved.

At Wednesdays meeting I announced that Wednesdays social evening would held at Leigh Oak, the venue has now changed to the Waverley RSL. Looking forward to seeing you there.

I attended the Launch on Saturday for the upcoming 2019 Multi District (Districts 9790, 9800, 9810, 9820) Conference in my role as our Club's On to - Conference Chair.

The Conference is well organised, thought provoking and has plenty of activities for Rotarians to be involve in ie breakout sessions, Youth Forum, Interactors/Earlyactors Forum, a Peace Forum and of course the gala Dinner. There will be 'What does Rotary do' Showcase in a large 3,000 sq. metre foyer and there is room to book space for those Clubs wanting to showcase their community work (cost \$300.00 for a 6m x 3m stand). The Conference is open not only to Rotarians, Rotoractors, Interactors and Earlyactors but also members of the public including students.

Venue: Melbourne Convention Centre

Costs:

Early Bird until 30th November \$175.00/person for both Conference days and after November 30th \$225.00/person.
Peace Forum \$75.00/ head. Gala Dinner \$110.00/head inc dinner, pre-dinner drinks, entertainment. Note - wives/partners of those Rotarians who are attending the Conference can attend the Gala dinner without have to pay the Conference fee. New to Club Rotarians who joined after January 2017 \$125.00/person.

The Gala Dinner is being held at the Melbourne Convention Centre but is limited to 1200 people and the advice from the organisers is for those who wish to attend the dinner is to book early to avoid disappointment.

I think that this will be an exciting inaugural combined Conference for the 4 Victorian Rotary Districts and from a Club view point offers a chance to meet other District Rotarians, the opportunity to listen and learn from other Clubs, exchange ideas and listen to some renowned keynote speakers including Ian Riseley, Sally Capp (Lord Mayor), Grant Hackett (Mental Illness), John Soe (victim of polio), Christine Nixon just to name a few.
