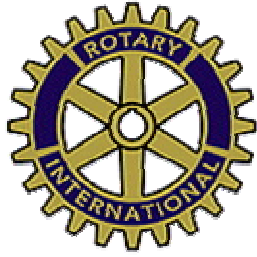

## Presidents Report for 18 April 2018



On a sad note I would like to pass on our Club's sincere condolences to Keith and his family on the passing of his sister.

At Wednesday night's meeting we had as our speaker fellow Rotarian Bill Haywood in his capacity as a committee member for ROMAC - Rotary Oceania Medical Aid for Children. 16 members listened intently as Bill presented an update on the ROMAC programme for children from developing countries especially those children from Timor Leste and PNG. This life saving or dignity restoring surgery has to-date had a 100% success rate and that is tribute to all the volunteers who give their services to this important Rotary programme.

At our monthly Board meeting last Wednesday night the Board approved donations to Rotary Health programmes including ROMAC, Interplast and RAM's. Letters of thanks were also received for the donation of \$1500.00 to Australian Rotary Health and \$1500.00 to the Rotary Foundation.

I also received an email from our DG Malcolm Chiverton advising that District 9810 is providing relief monies for the recent VIC and NSW fires, namely \$2500.00 each for the Bega and Western District fires. District is to be congratulated for providing these monies to help those so badly affected by these recent fires.

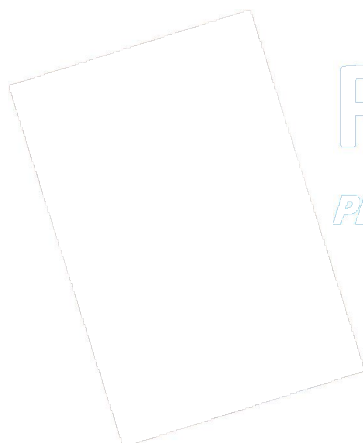

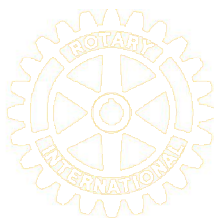
