### Presidents Report for 18 July 2018

We had an interesting meeting last week with about twenty members and guests present. It was good to see some of our travellers returning and I look forward to hearing about the International Conference when the others return.

We welcomed guests from the Indian Rotary Club of Hanumangarh District 3090 Mr JP Garg, his wife Mrs Manjula Garg past district chairman Inner Wheel District 3090 along with their son in law who lives in Mt. Waverley. JP went on to outline a project he is passionate about and works done in association

with District 9650 in NSW. As part of a Global Grants Program they have conducted programs to help improve sanitation and hygiene in girls schools by constructing toilets and installing water coolers since 2016. This has improved the lives of over 50,000 children. JP emphasised that this has been made possible through the friendship exchange program of Rotary. This years project is to install handwashing stations in remote schools of India.

Our guest speaker for the evening Deborah Hilton spoke about her research into the Benefits of Exercise and Physical Activity from a Population Health Perspective. Deborah discussed her research in the analysis of public screening to determine who is vulnerable to the onset of diabetes along with Baker Institute into who has the likelihood of getting diabetes. Deborah then went on to show her studies of the many statistics that covered a wide area of health and activity.

After the meeting a board meeting was held with the AG Bronwen Lamond attending. The main item discussed for the meeting was approving the upcoming years budget. The budget against actual will be reviewed in December to determine if we are on target for income so that we can continue with our planned projects.

For the rest of the year we have quite a few Bunnings sausage sizzles arranged so keep an eye out for Beths requests for volunteers. These are a great way to raise funds.

In last weeks bulletin a request was made for volunteers at the Waverley Music Eisteddfod, if you can assist please complete the roster in last weeks bulletin.
