Dear D9810 ROMAC Team,

We have been asked to look after another young patient from Timor Leste, arriving mid Feb. Lucilia will be accompanied by either her mother or her aunt.

Lucilia Soares, a 9yo girl has been receiving chemotherapy in Dili for a tumour in her neck, under the supervision of Prof Michael Sullivan from Melbourne (RCH). It has now been decided to bring her to Peter McCallum Cancer Centre for radiation treatment for 4 – 6 weeks, as an outpatient.

Robyn and Ken Dusting, from Docklands, have agreed to be her host family. Robyn became one of our ROMAC Volunteers this time last year when she visited Fidelcia in RCH and she and Ken have just come back from volunteering in Dili for 3 months.

When I have more information of Lucilia's arrival I will let you know.

Regarding our other current patient, Joana Dias Freitas, we are awaiting confirmation of her arrival date. There are some delays with issuing of visas (staffing issues/holiday break). The probable arrival week is W.C. 29 Jan 18. Everything our end is sorted with Dianne and Gavan McIntyre (RC of Wandin) ready to home host when she arrives and first appointment at RCH is scheduled for 2 February.
