



District 9810 Conference 2017 Geelong - Sponsorship Opportunities

The purpose of this email is to provide an opportunity for your club members to promote their businesses at next year's District Conference at The Pier in Geelong. Many Rotarian business owners and managers successfully and unpretentiously promote their business within a Club. This has the dual benefit of providing a trusted and reliable supplier for Club members and provides the business owner with valued clients. The District Conference provides an opportunity for Rotarians to promote their business throughout the whole District.

The plenary sessions at the Geelong conference (31st March – 2nd April, 2017) are expected to have up to 500 delegates. Delegates will be seated in a relaxed cabaret style setting with views of Corio Bay on 3 sides of the room. A Rotary expo will also be operating. There will be various opportunities for business owners to promote their businesses. Sponsorship packages between \$150 and \$2000 are available to interested businesses. The packages are available to any business and not just to Rotarian businesses owned by Rotarians.

Initially, the simplest form of sponsorship is through company advertisements in the Conference Program booklet. The DL size program booklet, a new initiative for the 2017 conference, contains the conference plenary timetable, bios of the keynote speakers and messages from Rotary dignitaries. A half page advertisement will cost just \$150 and a full page advertisement will cost \$300.

It would be appreciated if you advise the Rotarian business owners within your Club of this sponsorship opportunity. Also if you or any of your fellow Club Rotarians are aware of any local business owners who may want to take advantage of this opportunity could you on-forward this information.
