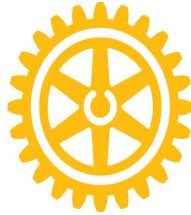

Presidents Report for 29 August 2018

We had another wonderful presentation from young people this week. Two attendees at the recent RYLA program gave some insights into what the program meant for them and also some of their thoughts.

Firstly Neha spoke to us about her experience. Some might remember her last presentation to us and as to how much of an inspiration she is. Neha has been involved in many activities at MWSC before RYLA. Neha was very appreciative of being given the opportunity to attend RYLA passed on her

sincere thanks to the club. It was interesting to hear her take on a presentation that was given at RYLA about the 7 strategies of life and how she appreciated being able to hear about these sorts of things at the age of 19 and not having to wait until later in life. There is no doubt Neha will be putting these strategies into practice.

Another interesting aspect was how she looks upon "The Positive Comments" book that was part of RYLA. It is something Neha said she will treasure for life as it is a great resource to look back on when there are times in your life where things may not be heading where you would like them.

The second speaker was Hayat and she also gave an interesting overview of her time at RYLA, how it was a bit of a challenge at first not having a set program and from that the realisation that she does not need to have control over everything. Hayat mentioned the knowledge gained was phenomenal and great for self consciousness. Another very positive aspect was the team building. One of Hayats pieces of advice she learned from the program was that we should always surround ourselves with fun, confident people who are willing to grow. Very good advice!

Haya also mentioned how much she appreciated the opportunity by the club and encouraged us to keep on giving the support, something we will definitely be doing.

From the question time some good pieces advice were passed on by Neha and Hayat. 1. Biggest life lesson, you have control, it is all mental. 2. Know peoples strengths and weaknesses. 3. As they went into the program with no preconceived idea it lead to great communication, socializing and the chance to do and experience many different things
