### Presidents Report for 3 October 2018

The discussion about the use of the Rotary logo led by Miranda helped improve everyone's understanding of the necessity in having a consistent image when using the Rotary brand, internally and externally. Also the use of social media will continue to be an ongoing discussion.

The explanation of our accounts structure was useful for the newer members of the club and a refresher for some of our long serving members.

A number of good ideas came up when discussing where we are as a club in the way of fundraising, the activities we support and volunteering. The annual report issued at the AGM a few weeks ago outlines all the activities we are involved in and if any members have not got a copy of the report, particularly newer members please let me know so that I can send you a copy.

When you look at the list of activities we are involved in, the importance of volunteering can't be overstated. Some of the things we are regularly involved in are, the Monash Children's Hospital, both in donating and fund-raising, Monash Waverley Community Information and Support (MWCIS), Rotary Foundation, Rotary Australia World Community Service (RAWCS), Australian Rotary Health, Youth, Mount Waverley Market, Bunnings sausage sizzles, Oakleigh Market just to mention a few.

Some of the points that came out of the discussion included:

- The club needs more volunteers to help with the fundraising activities
- The fundraising base needs to be widened
- The MWCIS food pick up on Friday mornings needs more volunteers
- If you are listed on a roster but cannot do your shift please swap with someone else on the roster rather than just telling the organiser
- The Oakleigh Market accounts for about 25% of our fundraising so full support is required. Two people are needed each week to meet our commitment. The roster for the market will be done shortly
- The Mount Waverley Market roster is circulated by Beth.
- We will review the suggestion that a form be circulated at meetings so that people can put their names down for when they know they will be available.

We had two potential new members at the meeting and I think it gave them a good insight as to what we are doing as a club and how we are open and willing to discuss new ways of doing things.

Thank you to everyone who joined in the discussions.

Adrian mentioned at the meeting that he will be running a car boot sale at the Oakleigh market on the 28th October and has invited anyone who has saleable items to include them in the sale. Some of the money raised will be donated to the club.
