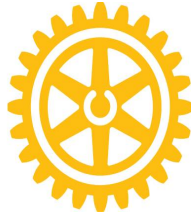

## Presidents Report for 5 September 2018

We held our AGM last week and a number of topics were covered. Some interesting discussions held. The minutes of the meeting will be published but just a couple of points of interest. The accounts for the 2017-2018 were reviewed and accepted and Michael Gidley agreed to his appointment as the accounts reviewer for another year. The final make up of the board for 2019-2020 will be announced by PE Beth in the near future, along with the committee chair positions.

I announced on the evening that Loretta has agreed to join this years board to help maintain our focus on community. There has also been some discussion in the club about the need to have someone who can act as the contact point and keep us informed about the welfare of members who may be going through challenging times. I am happy to announce that Robyn has agreed to be that person. We will keep you up to date as this position develops.

At the meeting Geoff Taylor requested support to load items onto his trailer for DIK. Unfortunately that couldn't take place as the fire that was well reported on the news was just down the road from DIK and therefore making the area not accessible. Geoff still needs volunteers for next Wednesday morning to complete this task.

We will discuss at the club forum later this month about the use of the new logo and where, when and what to use it on to ensure we have a consistent approach to our exposure in the community.

Fiona mentioned a possible screening of Bohemian Rhapsody in aid of End Polio Now. Please advise Fiona if you are interested. The date is still to be set.

Ron Brooks gave us an overview of the program he started in 2014/2015 to collect foreign coins to support UNICEF. Ron reported that since the inception of this activity 360kg of coins and notes have been collected which equates to \$11,200. At the meeting Fiona handed over our jar of coins which weighed in at 5.9kg! It is a great way to recycle scrap metal into something that is valuable to kids. It was interesting to hear that UNICEF partner with basically only QANTAS and CBA and very much appreciate now partnering with Rotary. The money currently being raised is being used to help the UNICEF project, Give Every Child a Future, which is aiming to immunise 100,000 children in the Pacific. Rotary has agreed to fund this project and the coin collection will continue to help this until 2020.

The Bunnings sausage sizzles continue and last weeks took in \$675 on a very cold, wet and overall awful day weatherwise. Thank you to all who continue to volunteer and work so hard at these very effective fund raisers.

On Friday night a larger number of our members and partners gathered at our place for a night of great socialising. Lots of memories, laughter, singing, dancing, eating and drinking made for a great evening. Thank you to all who attended and for what you brought along, mainly a very happy disposition. A special thanks to Rhonda for her as usual great organisation. I think the night was voted a success and look forward to doing it again sometime in the future.
