Presidents Report for 8 August 2018

We had an interesting presentation on Wednesday night from Doug Pendergast, the President of the Oakleigh-Carnegie RSL. Doug spoke about the revitalisation of the club buildings and the club focus. The direction was to re identify the club as an RSL club to increase the appeal to younger veterans and also community involvement in the club. Extensive renovations have been made to improve the facilities with more to come. A number of events are now held at the club that encourage community involvement. The member base is strong and is growing with a 50:50 split between veterans and social members. Doug also spoke about the struggles younger veterans face, particularly their participation in the workforce and also the struggle for welfare support

Next week we have the DG visit and it would be good to see a strong turnout of members and their partners.

I received an email from DG Russell detailing the link up of Rotary with the Today program and the National Farmers Federation to support the farmers suffering from the extended drought. The district has made an initial donation of \$2,500 and I will be recommending to the board that we make a \$500 donation.

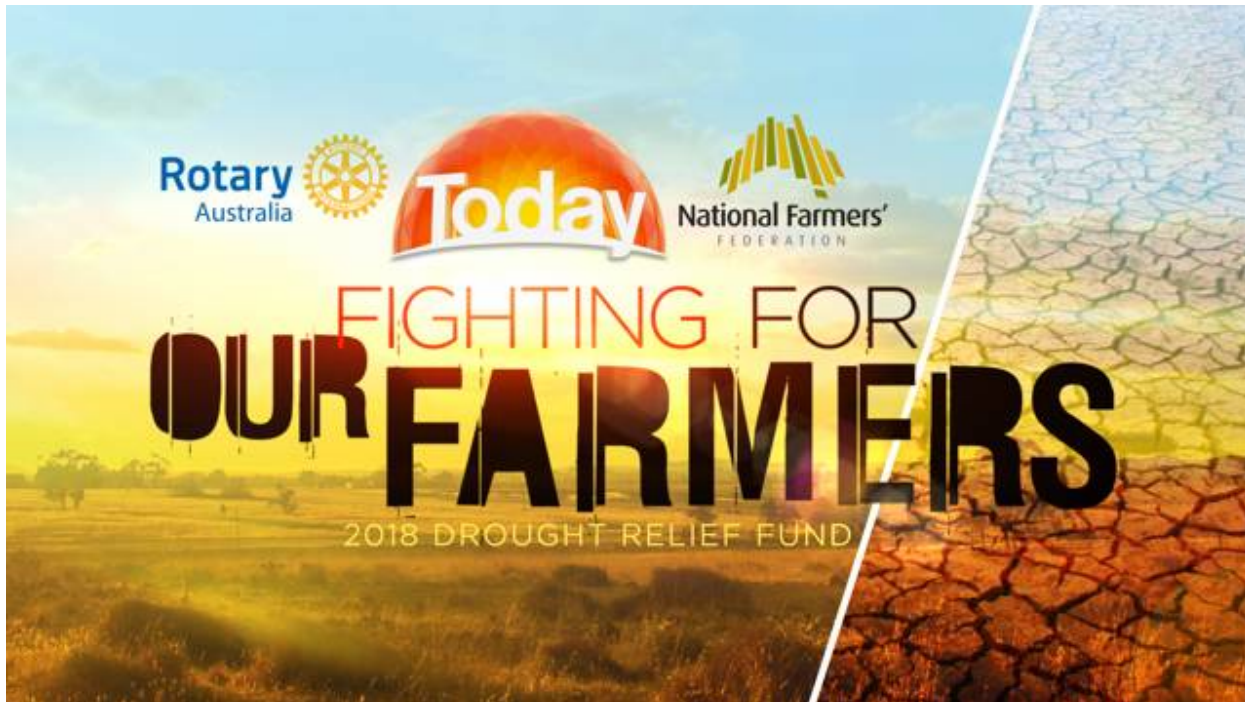
